The first day of school will be Wednesday August 15, 2007. There will be NO LATE START on the first day of school, but on the rest of the Wednesdays throughout the year (except during MAP testing weeks) we will begin school at 8:35 am.

In addition, this year we will begin a new student assistance and incentive program called [Eagle Time](#). [Eagle Time](#) will begin daily on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday at 2:35 pm. Juniors and Seniors with C or above grades in all classes with good attendance will be eligible for the incentive. All Freshman and Sophomore students will complete the school day in their 7th hour class and have time to complete daily work, homework, make up assignments, and get extra help from teachers or students who are assigned to tutor.
